The pastor will be an ex-officio member.</p> <p><i>(Reducing the size of the committee will more accurately reflect the size of our current membership roster.)</i></p> <p><i>(Having a prepared slate of member-at-large nominations to present to the congregation for election will eliminate the difficulties in reaching the required non-officers from the members in attendance at the Annual Meeting. This is within the duties assigned to the Nominating Committee in our bylaw according to Article VI.11 Nominating Committee - The Nominating Committee shall meet prior to the Congregational Meeting to prepare a slate of nominations to present at the meeting. These nominations are to fill the expired terms and vacancies of officers, boards, committees of the congregation.)</i></p>
